## Ashford General – An American Military Hospital from 1942 – 1946

The United States government purchased The Greenbrier and 7,000 acres of its property under the Second War Powers Act of 1942, transforming *America's Resort™* to "Shangri-La for Wounded Soldiers." During this time, over 25,000 soldiers were treated and tended to at Ashford General, primarily from WWII, and specifically *Operation Torch*.

# RULES OF PLAY

## The Ashford Etiquette

- ❖ **Awareness** – Please be aware of your surroundings and foul balls. Some greens are shared, do not play onto a green that is occupied with another group.
- ❖ **Group size** is not limited, but recommended to not exceed the player lines on the scorecard (6).
- ❖ **Thank you** for filling divots with sand, raking bunkers as you exit, and repairing all pitch marks you come across while playing on *The Ashford*.
- ❖ **Use caution** entering and exiting bunkers. The slopes can be severe, and we recommend exiting in an area with the least amount of pitch. This may be in the opposite direction of your shot to the green.
- ❖ **Lightning** – *The Ashford* utilizes a computerized lightning alert system, *Thor Guard*, an audible warning system. A 15-second long blast indicates to take shelter immediately. The “all clear” is a series of three, 5-second blasts. Neither the signal, nor the system is intended to guarantee that conditions are safe.
- ❖ **Restrooms** are located greenside, left of hole number four.
- ❖ **Ground under repair** – Please take free relief from rocks, sod seams, and any construction.
